The Town Council met for a regular monthly meeting at the Town Hall building, 12 Mitchell Street, Canajoharie, New York.

Supervisor Allen informs the Board that the County's dog law is in its' final stages, it is anticipated that the law will be passed at the July County Board meeting; Canajoharie Town Board can discuss in August it's decision to adopt the County's dog law, or extend the moratorium

Supervisor Allen asks the Board opinion on the County's presentation from March meeting concerning consolidated services; Councilman Toomey would like to know if the Town would have to participate in every consolidated service or pick and choose which service would be beneficial to the Town; Supervisor Allen indicated the answer to that is not clear, the County doesn't have a list of services to offer as of yet; Councilman Toomey suggests finding out what the County intends to consolidate before making any decisions on the topic

Supervisor Allen suggests to the Board that a fine schedule should be created for property owners who do not apply and receive a building permit; Councilman Armitstead suggests a fine in amount that

would be double the cost of getting an original permit in the first place

Councilman Armitstead inquires what the State Aid amount is on the reeval; Supervisor Allen answers approximately \$5.00 a parcel

## BILLS
