Councilman Armitstead questions whether Municipal Assessment Services has completed their duties regarding the reassessment project; Supervisor Allen states MAS are done; Discussion regarding the outcome of the Village business assessments; Supervisor Allen has not received a report from the Sole Assessor as of yet

**Highway Superintendent:** Bids were received regarding the retaining wall replacement on Happy Hollow Road; The engineering firm, AECOM, and Superintendent Hodge noticed mathematical errors within two bids received by KEK Excavators and by Gallo Construction; The bids are adjusted as follows: KEK Excavators \$208,849.00 Gallo Construction \$191,151.03; both companies apologized for their errors when contacted by Superintendent Hodge

Gallo comes out to be the lowest bid; AECOM indicates that the bid is not much over the estimate project cost, AECOM suggests consulting with the Town Attorney, and then call a special meeting to accept bid

Superintendent Hodge states that Gallo would be able to start work within a month-5 weeks as the Town needs to complete culvert work first

Superintendent Hodge will discuss the lowest adjusted bid with the Town Attorney and then request a special meeting to accept the bid

Superintendent Hodge also informs the Board that the first payment on the new truck has been made

Town Clerk- No comment

Supervisor Allen informs the Board that the health insurance rate is going to change 5.2%
