RESOLUTION #17, 2016 OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CANAJOHARIE ADOPTING THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (HMP) Sponsor: Councilman William Armitstead Second: Councilman John Peruzzi

WHEREAS, in response to the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000), Montgomery County, and the towns and villages located therein, have developed a Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP), which is an update of the 2008 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, DMA 2000 amends the Stafford Act and is designed to improve planning for, response to, and recovery from, disasters by requiring State and local entities to implement pre-disaster mitigation planning and develop HMPs; and,

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has issued guidelines for HMPs and the New York State Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Services (NYS DHSES) also supports plan development for jurisdictions in New York State; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Canajoharie Town Board recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Town of Canajoharie; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Canajoharie Town Board working in conjunction with Montgomery County and the constituent municipalities within Montgomery County, has prepared an annex that is incorporated into and made part of the Montgomery County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan of 2016 in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and,

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan of 2016 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long term risk to people and property in the Town of Canajoharie from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and,

WHEREAS adoption by the Town of Canajoharie Town Board demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Montgomery County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan of 2016.
