- Dedicated to closing the digital divide in Montgomery County, ensuring all residents can access and meaningfully use connectivity.

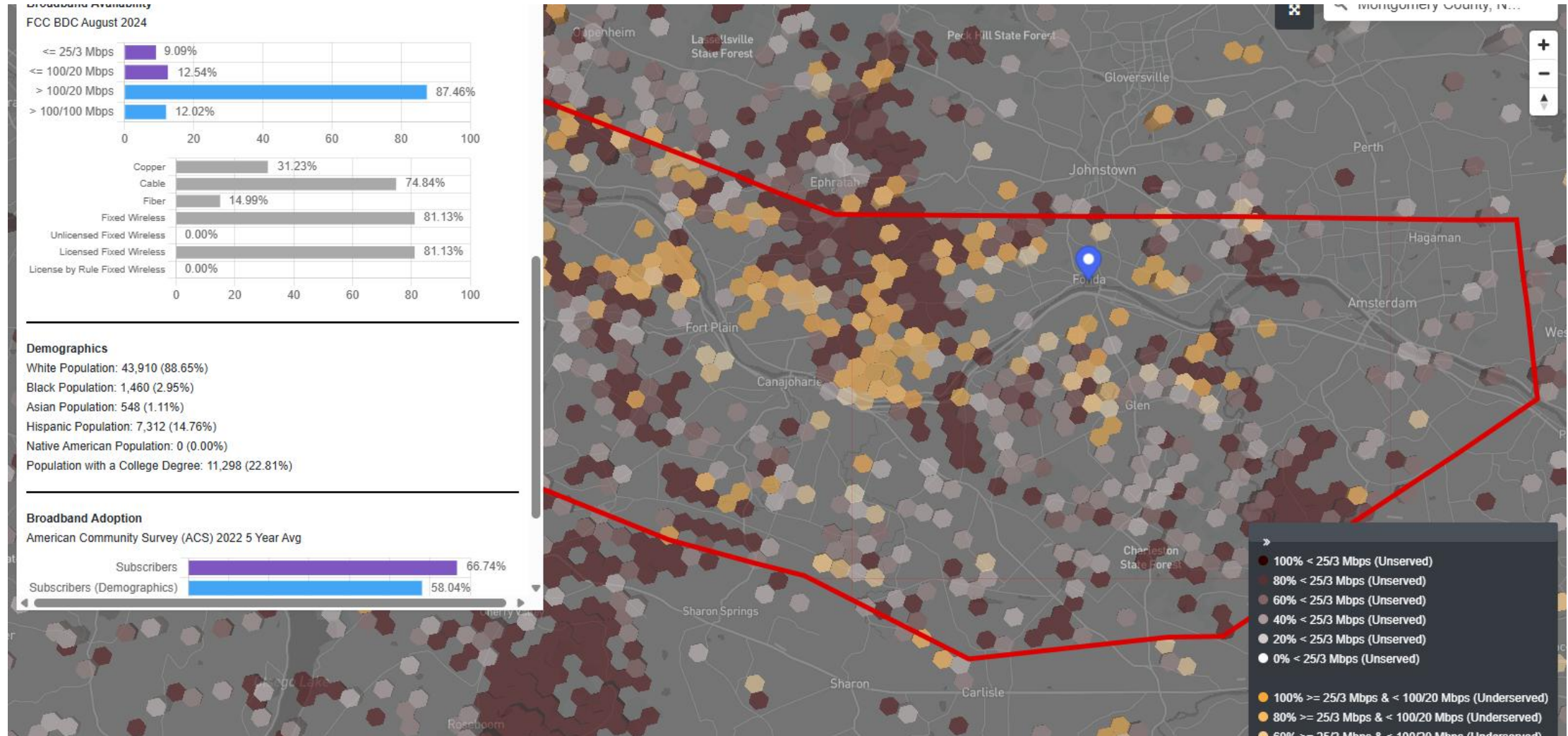


## Vernonburg Group

## What is the Project and Why Does It Matter

---

Montgomery County would like to enable the private broadband market to expand and thrive in Montgomery County so all residents can benefit from internet access.

- Secured funding and partnership from New York State ConnectAll program
- Contracted expert consultants from Vernonburg Group to help.
- Planning to utilize available public grants for incentivizing solutions to serving remote areas of the County.



# The Broadband Technical Assistance Project

---

**Objective:** To conduct a feasibility study examining the cost effectiveness and viability of publicly-owned broadband infrastructure, open access networks, and other public-private partnerships for broadband deployment.

**Activities:**

- Community outreach to ensure responsiveness to residents' priorities
- Existing infrastructure inventory and market research
- Exploring models and network designs to address gaps
- Conducting a cost analysis and business plan
- Evaluating financing and funding availability

**Intended Result:** An actionable plan for a connectivity solution that ensures all Montgomery County residents can get high-speed, reliable internet.

Network design and model evaluation	November - December
Cost modeling and financial planning	January - February
Funding strategy and final reporting	March

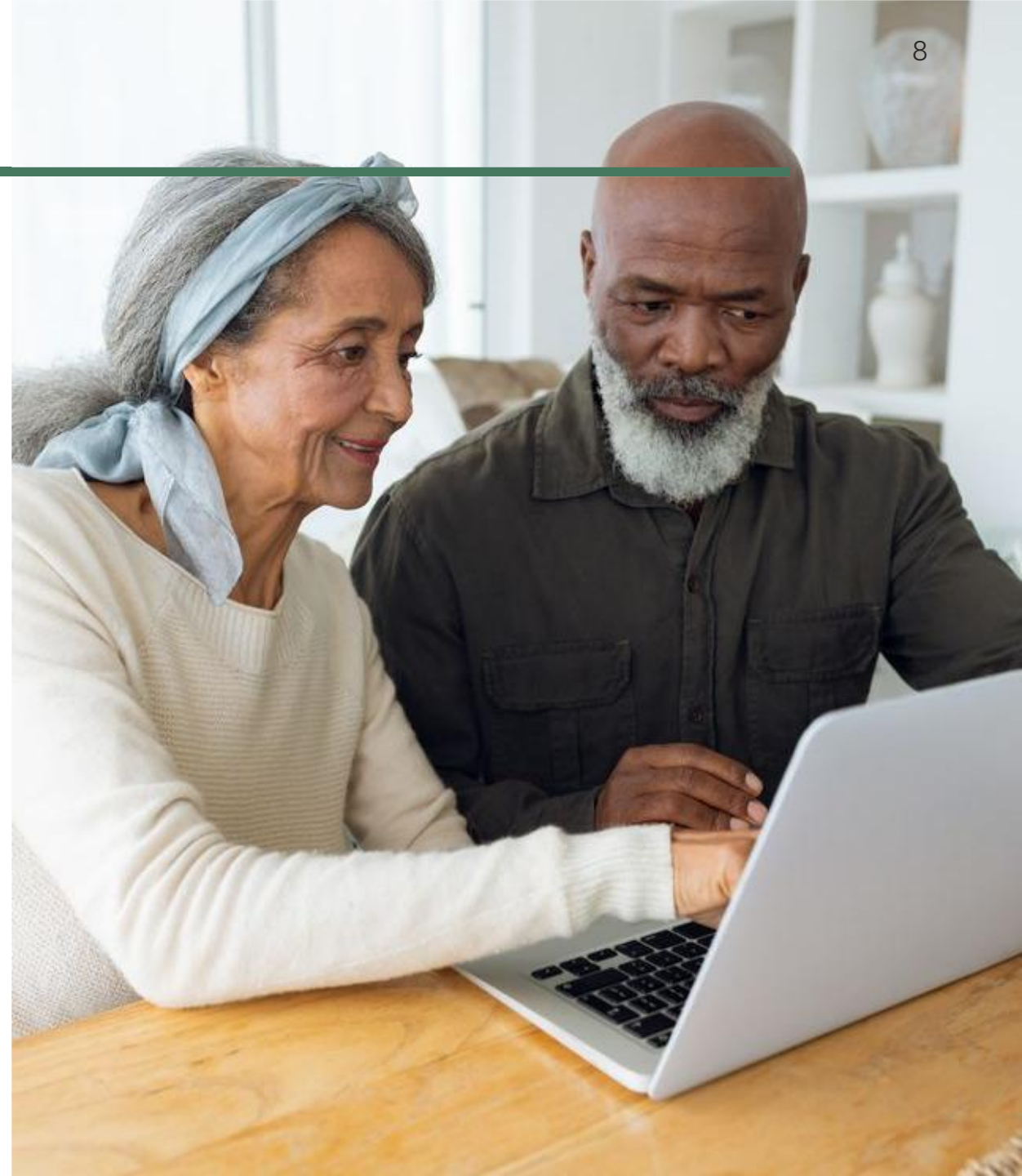

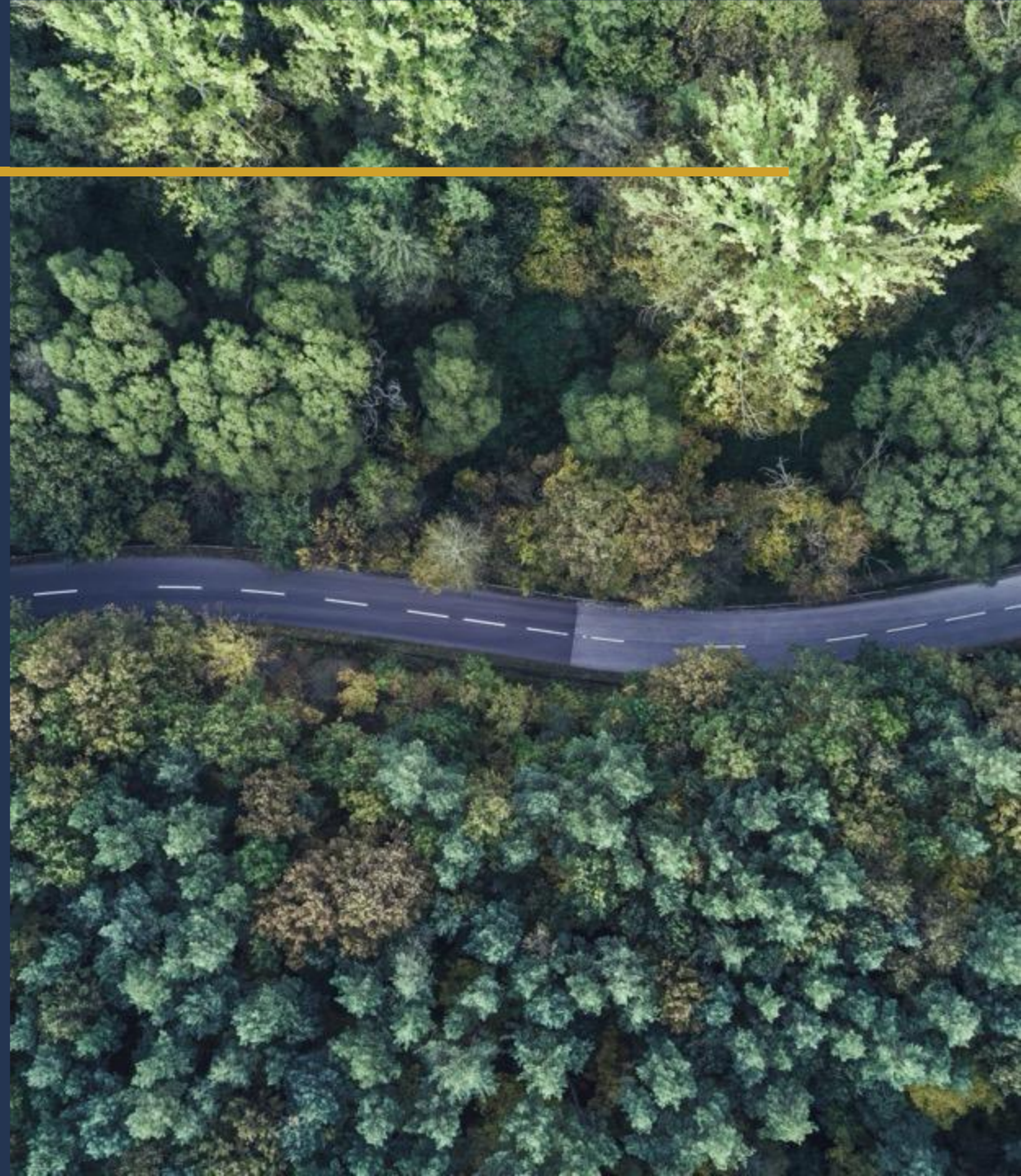
