SCOPE OF WORK

Montgomery County solicits responses from qualified Bridge Maintenance and Repair firms for bridge repair, rehabilitation, and/or alterations on County structures on an as-needed basis for the current construction season. The work generally shall consist of steel and concrete repair, scour repair, guide rail installation or repair, or other rehabilitation associated with yellow or red inspection flags or normal bridge maintenance at sites throughout Montgomery County as specified by the Commissioner of Public Works through written purchase orders issued to the Contractor by the County Purchasing Department.

The bridge maintenance crew shall be structured to meet the demands of each written job order. All work shall be paid on an hourly basis for the actual hours worked per classification. Price quotations shall include the following classifications: foreman with fully equipped field truck; carpenter with tools; iron worker with tools; welders, (fully certified for bridge welding by NYSDOT) and laborer with tools, each on an hourly basis.

QUALIFICATIONS OF FIRM

No response will be considered for award unless the firm submitting the response can meet the following conditions:

- The firm at the time of the response must have at least ten years' experience in repair or replacement of bridge structures for the State of New York and its political subdivisions. Each operator, supervisor, and foreman shall have equivalent experience.
- All material supplied shall be obtained from an approved NYSDOT source.
- The bidder shall possess a current and valid license to conduct business in the State of New York.

The Contractor is to supply all labors, small tools, transportation, goods and supplies, and deck washing equipment to properly execute the work as described herein. The written purchase order will describe the location, type of repair material, depths, widths and yield required.

The Contractor shall perform all work in a workmanlike manner with due regard to the safety and health of the employees and of the public, in full compliance with the provisions of all applicable laws. The Contractor shall be responsible for traffic control in full compliance with the provisions of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. All work shall be completed without environmental damage to any stream, body of water or drinking water source and be in conformance with the provisions of the County's Memorandum of Understanding with the NYSDEC or any permits issued by DEC or the Army Corps of Engineers.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The unit price bid shall include the cost of furnishing all labor, (including any supplements, holidays, or other "fringes"), small tools, transportation and goods and supplies necessary to complete the work as specified. The hourly rate for any crew shall be determined by applying the hourly rate per appropriate craft times the actual hours each person performs on the job within that craft. Holidays, travel times or other "time off" shall not receive direct payment.

LABOR: For each labor classification, the Contractor shall provide any required tools, including but not limited to chainfalls, come-alongs, or jacks; scaffolding, staging, ladders, formwork, or falsework; drills,

Roto-hammers or other pneumatic equipment; welders and supplies, torches and supplies; all safety equipment; and all traffic control equipment.

INSURANCE

Before the actual commencement of work, the Contractor shall file with the County liability insurance policies, with limits not less than the following amounts indicated:

The County of Montgomery reserves the right to extend any contract issued, based on this specification, under the same terms and conditions for a one year period from date of expiration, provided such extension is mutually agreeable to both County and Contractor.
