SECTION 1. Pursuant to section 90 of the General Municipal Law, overtime compensation shall be paid to the public employees employed in the Medical and Accounting Sections of the Montgomery County Department of Public Welfare for the time he or she is required to work in excess of his or her regularly established hours of employment; provided, however, that the total number of hours of overtime work in each of the sections hereinabove mentioned, shall not exceed thirty-five (35) hours per week; and provided further that regularly established hours of employment shall be at least thirty-five hours per week.

The hourly rate of overtime compensation shall be computed by dividing an employee's regular weekly compensation by thirty-five. The amounts received as overtime compensation shall be regarded as salary or compensation for the purposes of any pension or retirement system of which the employees receiving the same is a member. Such overtime compensation shall not be regarded as salary or compensation for the purpose of determining the right to any increase of salary or any salary increment on account of length of service or otherwise. No such overtime compensation shall be construed to constitute a promotion.

SECTION 2. This local law affects only those public employees employed in the Medical and Accounting Sections of the Montgomery County Department of Public Welfare and shall not be construed to include any other employee employed in any other section or department of the County of Montgomery.

SECTION 3. Overtime compensation herein provided for shall be paid out of moneys appropriated for and to the Public Welfare Department for personal services or out of moneys otherwise made available for the payment of overtime compensation.

SECTION 4. This local law shall take effect when filed in the office of the Secretary of the State of New York.
