COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY

LOCAL LAW No. 1

A local law fixing the salary of the Montgomery county treasurer.

Became a law January 31, 1970, no petition protesting. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of Montgomery. Filed in the office of the secretary of state February 16, 1970.

Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of Montgomery as follows:

Section 1. The salary of the Montgomery county treasurer be and the same hereby is increased to the sum of eleven thousand one hundred and twenty-five (\$11,125) dollars.

§ 2. This local law is subject to a permissive referendum and the clerk of this board of supervisors is hereby directed to publish the notice of adoption of this local law as required by section one hundred one of the County Law of the state of New York.
