Section 1. Where a vacancy in an appointive county office takes place and the right to fill said vacancy and the power of appointment is vested in the Board of Supervisors, a person, otherwise qualified, who is a member of the Board of Supervisors at the time the vacancy occurs may be appointed to fill the vacancy provided he shall have resigned prior to such appointment.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
