A local law "An Act Regulating Parking and Vehicular Traffic in County Owned Off Road Areas"

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

1. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any county owned, off-of-the-highway property where such stopping, standing or parking is prohibited by official signs or limited to a particular purpose unless using the area for that purpose.
2. No person, not handicapped, shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any area designated by an official sign as an area reserved for handicapped persons on county owned property.
3. No person shall operate a vehicle over any county owned off-of-the-highway parking lot or driveway at a speed in excess of that posted on official signs as the maximum speed for such area or driveway.
4. The penalties for violations of any of the provisions of this law shall be a fine of \$5.00 for a first offense and a fine of \$10.00 for each subsequent offense within one year.
5. An official sign is one erected or placed either pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Supervisors or by order of the Commissioner of Public Works of the County of Montgomery.

Resolution Supporting Legislation to Enable
 Facilities Development Corporation
 Aid in Construction of any Local
 Municipal Facility

Resolution by Supervisor Leo Knoeck
 Seconded by Supervisor Joseph Valikonis:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors
 of Montgomery County supports legisla-
 tion authorizing the Facilities Development
 Corporation to expand the scope of their
 activities to include ANY local municipal
 facility, rather than the restricted facilities
 stated in the law creating the Corpora-
 tion;

WHEREAS, bills previously filed to a-
 mend the law to permit such enlargement of
 scope of their activities have failed to
 become law; and

WHEREAS, Governor Hugh L. Carey
 has called upon local government to econo-
 mize;

WHEREAS, the Facilities Development
 Corporation has saved local jurisdictions
 thousands of dollars in the planning and
 construction of facilities currently author-
 ized by law, and can expand those savings
 by amending the law to plan and construct other
 buildings,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it hereby

RESOLVED, that the Montgomery
 County Board of Supervisors supports the
 approval of legislation enabling the Faci-
 lities Development Corporation to enter
 into agreements with municipalities for the
 design and construction by the Corporation
 of ANY local municipal facility, at the
 sole cost and expense of the municipa-
 lity; and be it further

RESOLVED, that, in the furtherance
 of Governor Carey's request that local
 government save money, it is respectfully
 requested that Governor Carey make the
 bill enlarging the scope of the Facilities
 Development Corporation an Administration
 Bill, and that he throw the prestige of
 his office behind passage of such bill;
 and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolu-
 tion forthwith be transmitted to Governor
 Hugh L. Carey; to the Facilities Develop-
 ment Corporation; and to Senator Hugh
 T. Farley, Assemblyman Glenn H. Harris
 and Assemblyman Arlington P. VanDyke.
