- l. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any county owned, off-of-the-highway property where such stopping, standing or parking is prohibited by official signs or limited to a particular purpose unless using the area for that purpose.
- 2. No person, not handicapped, shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any area designated by an official sign as an area reserved for handicapped persons on county owned property.
- 3. No person shall operate a vehicle over any county owned off-of-the-highway parking lot or driveway at a speed in excess of that posted on official signs as the maximum speed for such area or driveway.
- 4. The penalties for violations of any of the provisions of this law shall be a fine of \$5.00 for a first offense and a fine of \$10.00 for each subsequent offense within one year.
- 5. An official sign is one erected or placed either pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Supervisors or by order of the Commissioner of Public Works of the County of Montgomery.
