SECTION 1.(a) The annual salary of the following County Officer is hereby fixed at the sum opposite the office and designation of such County Officer, to wit:

(b) For the year 1989 on and after the effective date of this Local Law, the forgoing officer shall be paid at such a rate which, when added to amounts paid during the year 1989 prior to such effective date, will equal the annual salary fixed for such office.

SECTION 2. This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum, and will be submitted to a vote of qualified electors of the County of Montgomery, if, within 45 days after the date on which it was so adopted, there is filed with the Clerk of the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors a petition protesting against this Local Law, signed and authenticated as required by Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, by qualified electors of Montgomery County registered to vote therein at the last preceding general election, in number equal to at least ten per centum of the total number of votes cast for Governor at the last gubernatorial election held in said County.
