SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

THE County of Montgomery, through its County Board of Supervisors and in its proprietary capacity, declares that it is necessary, for the security, safety, protection and well-being of the public, its employees and its property, to place restrictions on the bearing and possession of firearms and other dangerous weapons and instruments by individuals while entering into and being present in buildings owned, leased and operated by the County of Montgomery.

SECTION 2.

This local law prohibits any individual from bearing or having in his or her possession, either openly or concealed, any firearm, gun, explosive device or substance, lethal or debilitating chemical or gas, or any dangerous or deadly weapon or instrument of any description, including, but not limited to a handgun, pistol, target pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun, dangerous knife, dagger, dirk, razor, still eto, imitation pistol or other items defined by the Penal Law of NYS, while entering into or while being present in any building owned, leased, or operated by the County of Montgomery.

SECTION 3.

This local law shall not apply to any authorized peace officer or police officer, as defined in the New York State Criminal Procedure Law, or any other authorized official of the County, State or Federal Government.

SECTION 4.

Failure to comply with this local law shall be punishable by confinement in the Montgomery County Jail for a term not to exceed three (3) months and/or a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This local law shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
