SECTION 1.(a) The annual salaries of the following County Officials are hereby fixed at the sum opposite the office and designation of such County Officials, to wit:

(c) For the years 1995 and 1996, the forgoing officials shall be paid at such rates which, when added to the amounts paid during the years 1995 and 1996 prior to such effective date, will equal the annual salary fixed for such offices. SECTION 2. This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum, and will be submitted to a vote of qualified electors of the County of Montgomery, if, within 45 days after the date of which it was so adopted, there is filed with the Clerk of the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors a petition protesting against this Local Law, signed and authenticated as required by Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, by qualified electors of Montgomery County registered to vote therein at the last preceding general election, in number equal to at least ten per centum of the total number of votes cast for Governor at the last gubernatorial election held in said County.
