Recently, John Snyder has resigned from the Montgomery County Industrial Development Agency Board of Directors and Capital Resource Corporation.

Following discussion with IDA Director Kenneth Rose, it is our shared recommendation that Laurie L. Weingart fill that vacancy. Mrs. Weingart is a resident of St. Johnsville and since 2007 has been employed as a licensed real estate broker and owner of Krutz Properties.

Krutz Properties is located in Canajoharie and recently opened two new offices in St. Johnsville and Mayfield. Mrs. Weingart oversees 16 real estate agents who are independent contractors for Krutz Properties. Mrs. Weingart, along with her employees, specialize in helping their clients/ customers find homes and focus on high ethical standards.

Mrs. Weingart is a lifelong resident of this region. She graduated from Canajoharie High School in 1990 and went on to receive a bachelor's degree in Healthcare Administration and Nursing Science.
