Dear Mr. Ossenfort:

It continues to be an honor and a privilege to provide inmate and staff food services at the Montgomery County Detention Center. This letter is to confirm an extension of our Agreement for another year through February 28, 2021, with a meal price adjustment. Pursuant to our Agreement, meal prices are to be adjusted annually based on the change in the Consumer Price Index, Food Away From Home data 60 days prior to the agreement anniversary date, which was 3.2%. Additionally, per Trinity's discussions with the County, we have extended the lower end of the existing Price Per Meal Scale to account for reduced inmate populations resulting from the recent legislative changes.

If this meets with your approval, please sign and return the enclosed amendment reflecting the changes referenced herein. Of course, please let me know if you have any questions.

Trinity sincerely appreciates the opportunity to serve the inmates and staff at the Montgomery County Detention Center. Thank you for your business. AMENDMENT TO FOOD SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Food Services Agreement is made by and between Montgomery County Correctional Facility, with principal offices located at 200 Clark Drive, Fultonville, NY 12072 (hereinafter referred to as "Client") and Trinity Services Group, Inc., a Florida corporation with principal offices at 477 Commerce Boulevard, Oldsmar, FL 34677 (hereinafter referred to as "Trinity"). The Client and Trinity are referred to jointly herein as the Parties.

WHEREAS, the Parties have entered into a Food Services Agreement made effective March 1, 2015, pursuant to which Trinity is providing Inmate Food Services at the Montgomery County Correctional Facility (the "Agreement"), and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to (1) amend the term of the Agreement to extend through February 28, 2021, (2) adjust the price per meal by an amount equal to three and two-tenths (3.2%) percent and (3) extend the lower end of the price scale to account for reduced inmate populations.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forgoing facts, the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree that the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

1. The foregoing recitations are true and correct and are by this reference made a part of this Amendment to Food Services Agreement.
2. The term of the Agreement is extended through February 28, 2021.
3. Effective March 1, 2020, the Parties agree that meal prices shall be adjusted by an amount equal to three and two-tenths (3.2%) percent which are reflected on the extended Meal Price Scale attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.
4. Agreement to, and acceptance of, this Amendment may be made and evidenced by facsimile signature or in an electronic form evidencing signatures of both Parties hereto.
5. Except as expressly stated herein, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
