34 years ago, this class was developed by Firefighter Andrew A. Fredericks. At that time, the fire service was starting to suffer from a shortage of members, especially but not limited to the volunteer ranks. Today, as we all know, departments across the nation have experienced a large drop-off in membership. With today's hotter, fastermoving fires, it is imperative that we get on the road ASAP and are ready to mount an aggressive interior attack especially where life-saving attempts must be carried out. This class will look at new apparatus and equipment designed to make our jobs less labor-intensive. In many places, where it used to take one or maybe two departments to handle the job at a single-family residence, now up to six departments are necessary due our diminished ranks. We must protect our residents and, just as important, our members and make sure everyone goes home.

Mike Healy has been a member of the Rockland County fire service for 54 years, serving with the Blauvelt Fire Department for 14 years, followed by the Central Nyack Fire Department for 40 years. He has served as a chief for three terms. Healy is currently the coordinator of education for the Rockland County Fire Training Center. Jeff Daniels is a 23-year fire service veteran. He served with the Air National Guard as a crash rescue firefighter for 17 years and was a member of the West Haverstraw Volunteer Fire Department for 14 years. In 2002, he was hired as a NYS DMNA firefighter and served for over four years before being appointed to the Fire Department City of New York (FDNY). Daniels was assigned to Ladder Co. 39 for 12 years before becoming an

instructor for the FDNY Fire Academy. Currently, he is a member of Squad 61 in the Bronx. He also teaches at the Rockland County Fire Training Center.
