

**Town of Glen Planning Board February 15, 2018 Report**  
**7:30 p.m.**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting**

**Meeting called to order at 7:30p.m.**

Planning Board Attendance:

Frank Casler, Donna Brooks, Nancy Langdon, and Rodney Kowalczyk.

A motion to approve our January 18 meeting report was made by Nancy Langdon and seconded by Donna Brooks. All were in favor to approve our meeting report.

**Subdivisions:**

R & R Farms minor subdivision approval.

A motion was made to approve by Donna Brooks, seconded by Rodney Kowalczyk. All were in favor.

Hall/Miller simple subdivision:

A motion was made to approve by Donna Brooks, seconded by Nancy Langdon. All were in favor.

**Old Business:**

Lystek Application Delayed due to Chazen Companies review. Resubmit planned for March 15.

**New Business:**

Town of Mohawk Letter received indicating they believe Lystek Business would affect Mohawk in a negative way.

Letter received from Braymer Law Firm demanding EIS and Positive Declaration.

Nancy Langdon suggested input from planning board be solicited prior to an issues response.

**Other:**

Both candidates (Farina and Helmin) were interviewed by the planning board.

Planning Board voted in brief Executive Session.

Vote was split, and no recommendation was made to Town Board.

**Public Comment was allowed for roughly 1 hr:**

Approximately 50 people attended and took part in a vociferous and sometimes hostile comment session regarding the possibility of Lystek building a fertilizer plant in the Glen Business/Industrial Park. Predominately repeats of concerns voiced last month.

Claudia Braymer spoke on behalf of the C.A.L.L. group and asked that the Planning Board reject the project as not permitted based on the TWMF 1998 law.
