Re: Industrial Wind Moratorium

Supervisor Tim Reilly, Board Members,

As you are aware a large, Industrial Wind Turbine was proposed in the Town of Glen with a second turbine being proposed 5 miles away in the Town of Florida. At the May 19 Planning Board meeting the application for this Wind Turbine was withdrawn, with a quote from Borrego Solar (applicant) that they would look to propose a new wind turbine in the Town of Glen in the future.

While working with our legal counsel on the wind turbine application, the Planning Board was advised that our local laws and local zoning do not sufficiently protect the Town of Glen from Industrial Wind projects. Legal Counsel suggested a moratorium on Wind Projects and recommended the implementation of a Wind Law.

The Town of Glen Planning Board has considered this recommendation and at the May 19, 2022 Planning Board meeting a motion was made to institute a 12-month moratorium on Wind Turbine Construction. The motion was carried as follows:
