

## Meeting Minutes

Town Board, April 13, 2020

- Present – attendance was limited to the 5 town board members, this meeting is closed to the public until NYS's PAUSE is lifted
- Meeting started at 6:40pm
- Approval of claims resolution, sponsored by Ron, seconded by Tom, all were in favor
- Approval of March meeting minutes, sponsored by Ron, seconded by Kirk, all were in favor

- Amend Resolution 21, Record of Activities, changing 90 day period to August 1 – October 31, sponsored by Tom, seconded by Ron, all were in favor.
- Resolution changing the minimum water usage per month to 5000 gallons, from 7500 gallons per month. This will make our water and sewer minimum usages consistent. Sponsored by John, seconded by Ron, all were in favor
- Amend Hwy Garage sale resolution, adding the following clause:

Said Resolution shall not take effect until thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption, nor until approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the Town voting on such proposition, if within thirty (30) days after the adoption of this Resolution, there be filed with the Town Clerk of the Town a petition signed, and acknowledged or proved, or authenticated by electors of the Town qualified to vote upon a proposition to raise and expend money, in number equal to at least five per centum of the total vote cast for governor in the Town at the last general election held for the election of State officers, but which shall not be less than one hundred in a town of the first class nor less than twenty-five in a town of the second class, protesting against this Resolution and requesting that it be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town, for their approval or disapproval. Sponsored by John, seconded by Ron, all were in favor.
